Overview

Epic Web Services (EWS) is the core integration layer of the Epic Systems platform, designed to facilitate seamless data exchange between the Epic Electronic Health Record (EHR) and third-party applications and systems. Available through the open .epic developer portal, EWS offers a comprehensive set of APIs and specifications that allow developers to build connected applications for various healthcare workflows. The services are purpose-built to address integration needs where standard protocols may be insufficient or overly complex. Key capabilities include:

Interoperability: Facilitating the exchange of patient records with non-Epic organizations and supporting federal frameworks like TEFCA.

Workflow Integration: Services for outbound faxing, print job management, document linking (e.g., to claims), and phone system pause/resume during credit card payments.

Core Data Access: APIs for essential functions like Patient Lookup, Identifiers, and Personnel Management (creating/updating user records).

Developer Support: Access to over 750 no-cost APIs and interfaces, with sandbox access and support available through Vendor Services.

Epic EWS targets third-party software vendors, health system IT teams, and app developers looking to integrate their products (e.g., medical devices, lab systems, coding systems, patient-facing apps) directly into the Epic ecosystem.

The Epic Web Services APIs are generally available at "no-cost" on the open.epic developer platform. However, the services require a client ID and a relationship with an Epic customer (a health system) to be utilized, as they are an extension of the core, enterprise-priced Epic EHR system.
