Overview

IntelliDoseTxM is a smart, cloud-based infusion management module designed for specialty practices, including oncology/hematology and urology. It is offered by IntrinsiQ Specialty Solutions, a part of Cencora (formerly AmerisourceBergen), and is the web-based version of the proprietary IntelliDose tool. The software is engineered to streamline clinical and administrative workflows, enhance patient safety, and increase staff efficiency.

Key Features and Capabilities

The platform centralizes critical functions into a single system:

Computerized Physician Order Entry (CPOE): Allows physicians to assign and approve treatment orders electronically.

Treatment Plan Management: Localized management of infusion care and immunotherapy regimens.

Nurse Charting: Comprehensive documentation of the chemotherapy encounter.

Automated Charge Capture: Captures all charges for each encounter, including J Codes, NDC codes, and wastage amounts, for faster and more accurate billing.

Clinical Decision Support (CDS): Includes protocol calculations and alerts for medication interactions, patient weight, and lab changes. It also integrates NCCN Clinical Practice Guidelines in Oncology (NCCN Guidelines) and NCCN Chemotherapy Order Templates for evidence-based decision support at the point-of-care.

EHR and Inventory Integration: Designed to seamlessly integrate with a practice's existing Electronic Health Record (EHR) application and features a bi-directional interface with the Nucleus Inventory Management system.
