It is available for selected Philips Magnetic Resonance (MR), Computed Tomography (CT), Image-Guided Therapy (IGT), Ultrasound, and Diagnostic X-ray (DXR) systems.

The program operates as a multi-year subscription, typically five years, and runs in tandem with an existing RightFit Customer Service Agreement . For a predictable service fee, it delivers regular software and hardware upgrades as they are released, regardless of the hospital's purchase cycle . This approach helps healthcare organizations manage their technology lifecycle, stay clinically advanced, and protect against obsolescence and cybersecurity risks .
