RareMD, developed by RareMD Inc. in 2016, offers two primary tools to shorten the diagnostic odyssey for rare diseases: RareMDx<sup>™</sup> for medical professionals and RareLook<sup>™</sup> for patients and caregivers.

RareMDx<sup>™</sup> for Medical Professionals This digital tool is specifically designed for frontline medical professionals to assist in early diagnostic decision-making. It enables users to input a patient's observable traits (phenotypes) and clinical data to generate a rare disease-inclusive differential diagnosis (DDx). The system uses a human intelligence (HI)–curated database of over 7,360 signs and symptoms and 4,023 rare diseases. A probability algorithm then generates a ranked list of up to ten suspected rare diseases.

RareLook<sup>™</sup> for Patients and Caregivers RareLook<sup>™</sup> is the layman-friendly version, empowering patients and their families to partner with their physicians in the diagnostic journey.
